PROVISIONS

That the total number of connections not exceed 35 as stated in the original Report of Exam.

An approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained in accordance with RCW 90.03.360, WAC 508-64-020 through WAC 508-64-040. Meter readings shall be recorded monthly and this data shall be maintained and be made available to the Department of Ecology upon request.

This permit is subject to the implementation of the minimum requirements established in the <u>Interim Guidelines</u> for <u>Public Water Systems Regarding Water Use Reporting, Demand Forecasting Methodology and Conservation Programs</u>, July 1990.

The permittee or its' successor(s) shall provide data on chloride concentrations for the well authorized by this permit with analysis performed by a state certified laboratory. Sampling shall occur April and August of each year and permittee shall submit by October 15th of the same year, written results for both sampling events to the Department of Ecology, Northwest Regional Office, Water Resource Program. Depending on the results of this data collection, withdrawal of ground water under this permit may be limited or other action required.

If pumping of the well authorized by this permit causes chloride concentrations to exceed 100 mg/l, the permittee shall be required to take immediate action to prevent concentrations from increasing. If corrective measures fail to prevent chloride concentrations from exceeding said level in the future, permittee shall relinquish the option to perfect additional allocated quantities regardless of the stage of development.

The permittee and its' successor(s) shall provide data on static water level monitoring (with pump off for minimum of 15 minutes) to be conducted April and August of each year. Written results for both sampling events shall be submitted to the Department of Ecology, Northwest Regional Office, Water Resource Program by October 15th of the same year.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
